



Stryn - Ålesund (one way)

Stryn – Hellesylt – Stranda – Sykkylven - Ålesund

This is a “Travel like the locals” tour. The tours use public transport, i.e. regular buses, ferries and boats, but we have done the planning for you so that you can concentrate on enjoying your trip. You travel on your own - there is no guide or tour leader. On most of our tours you must change several times between different buses/ferries/boats, and it is up to you to make sure you catch your connections – truly travelling like a local! (The tours are set up so that the buses, ferries and boats connect.)

On this trip you travel from charming Stryn to beautiful Ålesund through a varied and impressive landscape. The bus goes all the way from Stryn to Ålesund. There are no changes on the way.

You start in Stryn, a lively little town with shops, restaurants and other service offerings. The local clothing brands Ricco Vero and Skogstad are popular to bring home.

From Stryn the bus passes Grodås and drives through the Hornindal valley where you pass the Hornindalsvatnen lake – the deepest lake (514 m) in Northern Europe. The trip goes on to Hellesylt – and you will have a great view towards the Geirangerfjord. From Hellesylt, the trip continues to Stranda and the Strandafjellet mountain pass on to Sykkylven. The bus drives on board the ferry between Sykkylven and Magerholm and then continues the last leg to Ålesund town centre.

From Ålesund there are a number of other Travel like the locals trips you may take.
