



## Round trip to Molde & the Atlantic Road

Ålesund – Molde - the Atlantic Road - Ålesund

*This is a “Travel like the locals” tour. The tours use public transport, i.e. regular buses, ferries and boats, but we have done the planning for you so that you can concentrate on enjoying your trip. You travel on your own - there is no guide or tour leader. On most of our tours you must change several times between different buses/ferries/boats, and it is up to you to make sure you catch your connections – truly travelling like a local! (The tours are set up so that the buses, ferries and boats connect.)*

This trip takes you from Ålesund via Molde to what is often described as the world’s most beautiful road!

On your way you have some time in Molde to walk around this charming town between the fjord and the hills. Molde offers a magnificent view towards the fjord and the mountains on the other side, and has a multitude of shops, cafés, etc.

With its location at the edge of the mighty ocean, the Atlantic Road is as beautiful in sunshine and calm weather as in full storm and rain.

The Atlantic Road connects Averøy with the mainland via a series of small islands and islets spanned by a total of eight bridges over 8274 meters.

The Atlantic Road – Atlanterhavsvegen - is a Norwegian Scenic Route. Norwegian Scenic Routes are selected roads that run through landscapes with unique natural qualities, along coasts and fjords, mountains and waterfalls. The routes are intended as alternatives to the main roads, and the drive itself should be an enjoyable experience. On this round trip, the bus stops at Eldhusøya, where you can take a walk on the suspended walkway around the islet. The walkway consists of latticework (“grids”) “floating” above the terrain, and is suitable for or anyone.

The service building at Eldhusøya, with its distinct architecture that falls into the terrain, has a café and toilets.

The area also offers a magnificent landscape, a rich bird life and great fishing opportunities.

\*\*\*\* 27 June-21 August 2022: bus departure from Sylte skole at 17:41 and from Molde bus terminal 18:40.

Before 27 June and after from 22 August: bus departure from Sylte skole at 17:11 and from Molde ferry quay 17:50.

\*\*\*\*\* Leave the bus at Molde ferjekai (ferry quay). Walk on board the ferry and enter bus 100 during ferry ride.

(Applies before 27 June and from 22 August 2022.)

**Ålesund-Molde:** Take bus 100 direction Trondheim-Kristiansund from track 4 at Ålesund bus terminal (Rutebilstasjonen). The bus goes via Sjøholt, Vestnes and Furneset ferry quay to Molde. At Furneset ferry quay, the bus drives on to the ferry. On the ferry, you may leave the bus to visit the ferry's cafeteria and enjoy the beautiful view from the ferry. Make sure to get on board the bus before the ferry arrives in Molde, and take the bus to Molde bus terminal.

**Molde-the Atlantic Road:** The bus from Molde goes via Eide to the Atlantic Road. You change from bus 532/510 to 512 at Sylte skole (school). At the Atlantic Road, the bus stops next to the service building at Eldhusøya.

**The Atlantic Road-Molde-Ålesund:** From the Atlantic Road you take bus 510. Go to the bus stop sign that you will see at the end of the parking area.

Weekdays before 27<sup>th</sup> June and from 22<sup>nd</sup> August: Switch to bus 532 at Sylte skole (Sylte school) and leave the bus at Molde ferry quay. Walk on board the ferry and enter bus 100 during the ferry ride.

Weekdays 27<sup>th</sup> June – 21<sup>st</sup> August: Switch to bus 532 at Sylte skole (Sylte school) and take this bus to Molde traffic terminal. Switch there to bus 100 towards Ålesund.

On Saturdays, bus 510 goes all the way to Molde and you take it to Molde bus terminal and enter bus 100 at the bus terminal.

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
